



Technical Inspection Form

As a participant in this driving event, you are responsible for the safety of your car and should know the conditions of all items on this list. The following is a minimum list of items that should be checked by a qualified service facility prior to the event. The safety verification performed at the event is not a comprehensive technical inspection. NARRA and designated safety inspectors assume no responsibility for the safety of your vehicle. Any vehicle that does not pass the following safety inspection cannot participate in the event.

Certified Technician Must Initial

- 1. Windshield - no cracks; wipers functional with good blades.
2. Mirrors - securely mounted.
3. Brake Lights - all working and visible.
4. Pedals - throttle & clutch in good operating condition with full return; firm brake pedal.
5. Seat Belts - securely attached and in good condition. Equal restraints for driver and passenger.
6. Brakes - More than 50% pad lining, good system pressure, rotor no cracks
7. Brake Fluid - clean, full reservoir, Recommend dry boiling point of 580 or above.
8. Battery - securely fastened with no leaks.
9. Belts - tight with no cracks.
10. Fluids - NO LEAKS of any type any fluid: all hoses secure and pliable: all levels filled properly.
11. Suspension - no worn parts; no loose components.
12. Steering - tight and precise; no loose play in wheel.
13. Exhaust System - secure and no leaks.
14. Wheel Bearings - no noise or excessive movement. Proper free rotation
15. Wheels - No cracks, all lugs torque to manufacturer's specifications; valve stems with caps.
16. Tires - minimum tread depth 5/32 of inch (exceptions for race tires); balanced with no leaks.
17. Gas Cap - secure & tight. No Leaks.
18. Accessory Equipment - installed securely with no loose parts.
19. C/V Joints & Axles - no noise or vibration; boots intact.
20. Helmet - 2000 or 2005 Snell rating SA. M rating allowed first event.
21. Structural Integrity - No loose body or interior parts. No structural rust at or near suspension points.
22. Convertibles & Roll Bar - Mandatory for all convertibles cars without manufacture's structural or deploying roll bar. Roll bar must extend above drivers head.
